

Nina Betetto started her career as a judge of the District Court in Ljubljana where she became Head of the Civil Department in 1997. She has been a Judge of the Supreme Court of Slovenia since 2006. Her field of judging is review of lower courts judgements in civil matters. In the period 2011-2017 she was the Vice-President of the Supreme Court. She was the president of the Civil Section of the Slovenian Judges Association and the president of the Civil Law Study Commission of the International Association of Judges. In 2012 she served as GRECO evaluator. In 2013 she was appointed to the Bureau of the Consultative Council of European Judges (CCJE), in 2018 she became the Vice-President and in 2020-2021 she was the President of the CCJE. She has been the Head of the Steering Committee of a global project for the Slovenian justice with a wide range of innovative tools and methods, involving judges and court staff 'Improving the quality of justice'(IKS). The project was awarded a CEPEJ 'Crystal Scale of Justice' prize in 2019. Her academic work, since becoming judge, has included international expertise on various aspects of civil law and mediation. She continues to teach at workshops and seminars for judges and mediators, and to work as an expert in Slovenia and abroad. She also serves as a mediator in a court-annexed mediation programme. She has published widely in the field of civil justice and mediation in Slovenia and abroad.
