Born in Ljubljana, 1947. Graduated in 1969 on the Law Faculty in Ljubljana, where she also received the Doctor's degree in 1981 on the basis of the doctoral thesis "Void Contracts". In 1970 she started to work as an assistant at the Law faculty in Ljubljana. In 1981 she was elected in the scientific title of "docent" (senior university teacher), in 1987 was promoted to a senior lecturer (associate professor) and in 1993 to a full professor. In the years 1970 – 1971 she was working as a probationer at the Law court in Ljubljana and passed the jurisdictional exam. She was several times improving in Vienna, Salzburg, Regensburg, Trieste, Leiden, Paris and elsewhere.

Her fields of scientific and pedagogical work are particularly Private international law and Law of Obligations (Torts and Contracts). Among other monographs she has issued a book on Void contracts (1982) and a Commentary on the Private international law (1983 and 1992) and several articles in law revues. She participated in the commentary on the Code of Obligations (2003, 2004) as well. She took part in more working groups preparing new Slovenian legislation. She has actively participated in many conferences in Slovenia and abroad (Reykjavik, Utrecht, Tokio, Seattle, Bratislava, Taipei).
