Definition

“A judgment granted on a claim or defense about which there is no genuine issue of material fact and upon which the movant is entitled to prevail as a matter of law.” – Black’s Law Dictionary (2009)

English Civil Procedure Code (Rule 24.2):

„The court may give summary judgment against a claimant or defendant on the whole or a claim or on a particular issue if –

- a) it considers that (i) claimant has no real prospect of succeeding on the claim or issue; or (ii) that defendant has no real prospect of successfully defending the claim or issue; and*
- b) there is no other compelling reason why the case or issue should be disposed of at a trial.”*

Definition

Elements of a summary judgement:

- *dispute that does not concern a question of fact*
- *there is no need for additional evidence taking or a trial*
- *purely based on documentary evidence*

Definition

Summary judgements and expedited proceedings:

Summary Judgements:

- no agreement needed
- no evidence taking needed
- no trial needed
- does not concern time, but substance



Expedited proceedings:

- agreement of both parties (Art 48 LAR; Art 45 Vienna Rules)
- shorter time limits
- usually one arbitrator

2. Admissibility

Admissibility depends on four variables:

– *lex arbitri*

- Does the *lex arbitri* allow for summary disposal of a case?
- Tribunal's duty to determine facts?
- Parties' right to be heard?
- Duty to render an enforceable award?

– *And the lex fori?*

3. Enforcement acc. to NYC

Article V NYC

Enforcement may be refused, if:

(b) The party against whom the award is invoked was [...] otherwise unable to present his case;

→ **determined by lex fori**

(d) The [...] arbitral procedure was not in accordance with the agreement of the parties, or, failing such agreement, was not in accordance with the law of the country where the arbitration took place;

→ **determined by lex arbitri**
