- Principles of allocation
 - ✓ Control
 - ✓ Forseeability
 - ✓ Bearing
 - ✓ Benefits or sufferings
- → Consequences on procurement

Allocation of Risks (2)

- Specific risks
 - Quantities
 - ✓ Information provided by the Employer
 - ✓ Unforeseen ground conditions
 - √ Force majeure
- → Indemnities and insurances

DEFINING CONSTRUCTION DISPUTES

Contractor's Claims and Remedies

- Extensions of Time (EoT)
- Variations
 - Scope of contract
 - Price adjustment
- Force Majeure
- Payment
 - Non-payment, late payment
 - Financing charges, suspension, termination
- Termination
 - Payment
 - Return of retention money, guarantees, etc.
- → Procedure (notices, waivers, etc.)!

DEFINING CONSTRUCTION DISPUTES

Employer's Claims and Remedies

- · Claims related to timing/completion
 - Liquidated damages
- · Claims relating to quality of works
 - During performance
 - After completion/taking-over
 - After defects liability period
- Termination
- Payment/Set-off
 - Withholding payments
 - Withholding retention moneys
 - Setting off liquidated damages
